Scientific seminar will be timed to [XVII April International Academic Conference on Economic and Social Development](#) (NRU HSE, Moscow, April 16 – 22, 2016) and will be a part of the conference as its “philosophical session”.

International scientific seminar on transcendentalism in 2016 is conceived as a trial of a scientific project on transcendental philosophy in Russia. It is timed to birthday of I. Kant (born on April 22, 1724), the founder of transcendental philosophy.

Panel discussion *On the possibility of contemporary transcendental philosophy* held during [VII Russian Philosophical Congress](#) on October 9, 2015 (video of the discussion:

<https://youtu.be/PKI3HDntpZc>) precedes the suggested seminar. The panel discussion allowed to unite those who consider themselves to be adheres of transcendentalism, although the meaning of the term is very broad. In future it is planned to carry out a full-fledged international conference on the basis of the seminar and establish a regular Russian scientific event dedicated to transcendentalism.

The aim of the seminar is to discuss contemporary problems of transcendental philosophy in its main three theoretical forms that are Kantianism, Neokantianism in its continental version, and transcendental phenomenology together with analytic Neokantianism. Most prominent Russian scholars are invited to participate in the event. The list includes N. V. Motroshilova, L. A. Kalinnikov, I. V. Molchanov, V.V. Vasiliev, A. N. Kruglov, D. N. Raseev, V. N. Belov, N. A. Dmitriev, and others. It is also planned to invite international scholars of this tradition like Robert Hanna, USA, Karin de Boer, Belgium, M. Soboleva, Austria, Alexander Schnell, France/Germany. A. Schnell will present his book on speculative transcendentalism during the seminar.

Main topics of the seminar are:

- Kant’s transcendentalism as a specific paradigm and style of philosophical consideration
- Kant’s transcendentalism and its development in contemporary philosophical tradition, in phenomenology in particular
- Kant and Husserl: two variants of modern transcendentalism
- Kant’s transcendentalism and its development in contemporary analytic Anglo-Saxon tradition
- Kant’s transcendentalism and its development in contemporary Russian philosophical tradition

Program of the seminar:

22.04.2016 (Friday): two sessions (morning and afternoon)

23.04.2016 (Saturday): morning session, presentation of A. Schnell’s book, excursion

Each session presupposes 1-2 keynote papers (single paper or co-presentations) and 2-3 papers. Number of talks is limited.
